Cross Platform New Features and Fixes

This section describes the cross-platform new features and fixes contained in this release.

New Features:

- Added support for OpenFX effects plugins. (Lightworks Pro Only) Tested and verified plugins include:
 - NewBlue Version 7.8.210803 (TotalFX, Titler Pro, Elements, Transitions, Filters, Stylizers and Essentials)
 Windows and Mac Only
 - o Boris FX version 2021.5 (Continuum and Title Studio) Windows and Mac Only
 - Boris FX version 2021.5 (Sapphire)
 - O Maxon Version 14.0.4 (Magic Bullet Looks) Windows and Mac Only
 - Other OpenFX effects from other venders may work and we hope to build a list of other plugins as verified by customers
- Added support for audio plugins in VST3, AudioUnit and LADSPA formats. (Lightworks Pro Only) Tested and verified plugins include:
 - Waves Version 13.0 (All plugins version)
 - Accusonus ERA Bundle Version 6
 - Melda Plugins Version 15 Beta (Free Bundle)
 - Sonnox (Inflator, Reverb and Envolution)
 - Other Plugin effects from other venders may work and we hope to build a list of other plugins as verified by customers
- Added the ability to search within all the Effects categories
- Added support for non standard frame rate media
- Added bezier handles to our 'Graphs' tab
- Improved the output file of Changelists to be more up to date
- Added the ability to switch between abbreviated and non-abbreviated track names on the timeline appearance panel
- Updated to the latest Blackmagic RAW SDK (2.2)
- Added the ability to search for "Images" within the Search panel
- Component sub category now appears at the top of the Effects list
- Added initial support for new licensing refactoring to improve flexibility
- Always default to the 'Fixed' project layout if no preference has been explicitly set
- Changed track sync-loss to always use the bottommost video track as the master
- Restored correct messages when encountering expired licenses on startup
- Added ability to show missing media locations on the 'Media->Locations' tab of the project card
- Avoided creating a new empty sequence when restoring an archive project (Fixed layout)
- Added social media playback formats to the list available on sequences
 - O Added three new sequence output formats: 'Portrait Large', 'Square Large' and 'Portrait 4:5'
 - Added corresponding menu-item for each of them has a tooltip which lists the social network formats that are compatible
- Added five new export menu formats: 'Twitter', 'TikTok', 'Snapchat', 'Instagram' and 'Facebook' (Lightworks Pro Only)
- Added ability to SHIFT click the effects bypass button to disable/enable all effects on the current segment
- Added ability to un-minimise audio plugin editors by clicking the launch button
- Removed 'Free' text from the H.264/MP4 export option when Free licenses are active
- Removed the default 'Auto' enabled effects from the VFX tab
- Renamed 'Web Video Platforms' on the export panel to 'Social'
- Simplified the way that audio mix presets are saved/loaded from the audio mixer panel

Fixes:

- Fixed two hyperlinks being created when successfully exporting to Reaper
- Prevented tooltips from appearing when positioning the mouse over the image of a viewer (Flexible layout)
- Fixed potential crash double clicking a Sync into an open source viewer
- Fixed Mark/Park on tiles not being consistent between the timeline of a tile and when opened into a source viewer
- Fixed potential crash double clicking a Sync into an open source viewer
- Fixed projects created from earlier versions of Lightworks not being upgraded to 2021 correctly
- Fixed Cue Marker icon appearance in fullscreen playback
- Fixed password issues containing & or @ when generating license files
- Prevented twin play functionality from treating a source sequence like a Print
- Fixed removed audio plugins from appearing after from the user's system, the Lightworks audio plugins list is not updated
- Fixed Lightworks Pro Year license showing no expiration date on the last day of the license expiry
- Fixed appearance of Fusion plugin thumbnail image on the Plugins effects panel
- Fixed audio EQ only working if it's the first effect in the signal chain
- Fixed inability to make a sequence from Cues on the Cues panel
- Fixed Accusonus screen overlays for Voice autoEQ not working
- Fixed issue of audio cutting out randomly during playback
- Fixed Fusion plugin showing as empty
- Fixed abbreviated track name persistence
- Fixed some MP4 sample files turning black before the end of the file
- Fixed audio segment getting deleted when removing an EQ effect from 2021.3
- Fixed the effects panel using tabs when there is insufficient room
- Fixed incorrect audio levels being shown when decreasing the volume on the LR mix
- Fixed obscured scrub bars on tiles within multicam bins
- Fixed missing video track on some Apple ProRes media in MXF format
- Fixed interlaced Avid DNxHD transcoded media displaying as a green tile
- Fixed consumer (HiFi) levels setting being ignored within the Blackmagic hardware settings
- Fixed issues with audio plugin lookahead buffering playing the previous buffer when playhead jumps to a new location
- Fixed sequences appearing in the project with 'Missing source' after deleting a loaded sequence from the record viewer
- Fixed all audio effects disappearing from the Settings panel if a plugin is added to an EQ from 2021.3 then removed
- Fixed bin sorting when unusual characters are present in field attributes
- Fixed AAF export failing from sample sequence
- Fixed locally created file on YouTube/Vimeo export still being held open by the application
- Fixed potential crash showing Effect thumbnails
- Fixed incorrect scaling on 'Unjoined cuts' when set to 'Curled'
- Fix crash on startup removing redundant Effect templates
- Fixed errors importing embedded AAFs
- Fixed inactive hyperlink after a successful render (VFX tab)
- Fixed potential hang applying an OpenFX plugin on a Mark/Park region
- Fixed memory leak when working with HD media that requires FFMPEG (making proxies from HEVC media)
- Fixed V tracks swapping around after adding a new V track then exiting and re-entering the project
- Fixed key assignments for live editing not working if the first source does not have focus prior to playback
- Fixed 'Remove cue marker' shortcut key not working within a ranged marker
- Fixed sequences ending up with inaccessible black segments at the end
- Fixed audio stuttering and cutting out when playing a section with audio plugins applied

- Fixed hang with OpenFX plugins that use images from multiple segments in the sequence
- Fixed last minute of sample MP4 file turning black (again)
- Fixed BITC for cues can be incorrect
- Fixed the 'Overlay Enabled' checkbox not working
- Fixed the guided tour on the EDIT tab not working due to abbreviated tracks
- Fixed the track selection option being ignored when making a copy of a marked section
- Fixed blank thumbnail images shown on the alternate clips menu
- Fixed incorrect order of thumbnails shown on the alternate clips menu
- Fixed incorrect frame being shown on the alternate clips menu
- Fixed sample MP4 file turning black (yet again, requires re-import)
- Fixed audio tracks showing as greyed out but not actually disabled after clicking and dragging the track header button
- Fixed inability to move a timeline with the right mouse button when 'selectable segments' are enabled (Flexible layout)
- Fixed inability to change the import mode for multiple sound files at once on the batch import panel (Flexible layout)
- Fixed 'Media > Transcode' not being available when right clicking a selection of bin items (not just one)
- Fixed inability to move grouped tracks if selecting the incorrect one prior to the move
- Fixed audio stuttering on playback after applying audio plugins

• Fixed potential crash browsing to and importing MP4 media files

Limitations and Known Problems in Version 2022.1

This section describes the limitations and known problems contained in this release.

Cross Platform

- Potential hang attempting to add a Boris Effect to a clip if the thumbnail image is grey
- Audio plugin effects can not be added as 'Favourites'
- There is no Effects vendor categorisation in the Video/Audio Effects lists
- Depending on the amount of third party plugins installed on the system, the first startup of this new version may be slow and consume memory
- H.264 Proxy files will fail to be created from high frame rate media
- Some proxy images may have incorrect black bars surrounding the image
- Some proxy files generated from H.265/HEVC media may be incorrect
- Issues generating proxy files from 4k media with codecs other than H.264
- Contour ShuttlePROs will not work unless you duplicate the 'Lightworks' settings in their app and then point it at the new 2021.2 release
- Prints containing multiple V tracks and DVEs used will not display correctly in a sequence
- DVEs may change position when switching to a different sequence output
- MXF, AVI and MOV export options have an incorrect mix of PAL and NTSC options
- H.264/MP4 exports at 23.98fps show the audio sync is half a frame out
- PAL/NTSC source files thumbnails/viewers may not play out on the hardware I/O
- Freeze frames, in sequences exported to AAF, are ignored in Adobe Premiere (XML works).
- Proxy files are not created for files shorter than one second in length, when set to H.264.
- A crash may occur when attempting to export an image sequence from a sequence containing 16-bit DPX files.
- After removing a media space, with the import panel open, Media may appear offline.
- Some MTS files show pixelation on the start frames.
- The Video Analysis tool appears through the FX configuration panel when configuring a color correction effect.
- The Audio Monitor Delay setting is not accounted for during export.
- AVID DNxHD 10bit encode is not possible.
- There is no support for importing .WMV files.
- Make sure all applications are closed before attempting to install Lightworks.
- The ability to transcode 1080p 60fps files on import to AVID DNxHD, is not supported.
- Blu-ray VC1 export does not generate a valid file, instead it imports back as Sound only.
- Audio on exported AVCHD files cannot be played by Windows Media Player. The audio is muted.

Windows 64-bit

- There is no QuickTime Movie/MPEG4 import/export via Apple SDK.
- After Effects plug-ins are not supported.

Linux 64-bit

- Debian Distros:
 - O Ubuntu/Lubuntu/Xbuntu 18.04 and higher
 - Mint 17 and higher
- RPM Distros:

- o Fedora 30 and higher
- Fedora is only supported when enabling Xorg. There is no support for Wayland (default) currently.
- Custom plugin user interfaces are currently disabled
- Fedora installs fail if using Mesa drivers.
- There is no QuickTime Movie/MPEG4 export option.
- There is no .WMV import.
- ATI and Nvidia cards are supported. LWKS Software LTD recommends Nvidia for the best performance.
- There is no FX plug-in support.
- Do not use linux default GFX driver. If you experience the viewer playing at a reduced size then the Linux default graphics driver is installed. Make sure the Nvidia driver is loaded and that the system is restarted.

Mac OS X 10.11 and Higher

- · Potential loss of output clicking the voice over icon on a sequence with AJA hardware enabled
- Any users running Macbook Pro systems MUST disable 'Automatic graphics switching' under 'Energy Saver' in 'System Preferences'.
- Lightworks supports Mac OS X 10.11 (El Capitan) and higher, earlier versions are not tested
- There is no H.264 MOV export.
- There is no QuickTime/MPEG4 export option.
- There is no Apple ProRes 4444 export option.
- There is no support for Matrox I/O hardware.
- The shared project feature is not currently operable.
- Video overlay may change brightness on playback when running dual monitor setups.
- MTS Playback may be poor.

Matrox Hardware I/O

- If your system is not fast enough or does not have sufficient memory, the captures using MXO2 will stop with a 'dropped-frame' message.
- If the drives you are recording to are not fast enough the captures using MXO2 will stop with a 'dropped-frame' message.

Limitations and Known Issues With Boris FX Continuum (Windows and Mac only)

- There is a crash opening Mocha Motion Tracker on some plugins
- The image background is missing when opening up BCC Mocha Pixel Chooser
- OpenFX transitions between segments of different dimensions are not correct
- Potential hang attempting to add an effect to a clip if the thumbnail image is grey

Limitations and Known Issues With NewBlue FX (Windows and Mac only)

- When opening the Titler Pro plugin there is a long delay waiting for the plugin to open and display the licensing panel (NewBlue issue)
- Rendering may be incorrect on Title effects (NewBlue issue)
- Thumbnail images may fail to continue showing an image after adding multiple effects (NewBlue issue)
- Uninstalling NewBlue may result in text not showing within Lightworks, please restart the system (NewBlue issue)
- There may be a hang working with NewBlue titles (NewBlue issue)

Limitations and Known Issues With Accusonus Plugins (Windows and Mac only)

ERA plugins do not apply processing when exporting the sequence

Blackmagic Hardware I/O

- Input or Output only devices cannot be used. Lightworks requires both an Input and an Output to be present on the device.
- USB 3.0 devices may not work correctly on a Mac running Windows Bootcamp.
- Audio monitor level control has no effect on Blackmagic recordings.
- You will not be able to view video on the Blackmagic output if Precision is set to 10-bit. Change setting to 8-bit
- You will not be able to view video from Boris Red via the Blackmagic Output when Lightworks is running.
- SDI Output does not playback smoothly if a title has been applied to the material.

AJA Hardware I/O

- Audio monitor level control has no effect on AJA recording.
- There is no E-E when using the KONA LHi during recording.
- If your system is not fast enough or does not have enough memory, the captures using AJA devices will stop with a 'dropped-frame message.
- If the drives you are recording to are not fast enough, the captures using AJA devices will stop with a 'dropped-frame' message.
- AJA/BMD SDI Output does not playback smoothly if a title has been applied to the clip.
- On Kona 3G SDI 2 output must be used with Windows 64bit.
